
CELEBRATIONS

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SCHOOL GOALS



GOAL 1 Staff will commonly develop, implement, and evaluate assessments

By focusing on assessment practices, it provides an opportunity for teachers to ensure that our assessment practices are accurate, fair, and consistent while reflecting the changing curriculum.

In grade level teams, teachers will create or modify current subject specific assessments to demonstrate curriculum outcomes. They will also collaboratively evaluate assessments to ensure common expectations and assessing of student responses.

STRATEGIES



Common Team Time: Teachers will meet with other grade level teachers on a regular basis to discuss and develop assessments which will lead to improved instruction and assessment practices.

Grade Level Meetings: Administration, Learning Support Teachers, Family

School Liaison and the Making Connections Worker will meet with grade specific teachers to develop support plans for students with unique circumstances. This allows for a team approach to addressing the needs of all students.

Professional Development: We use time when we are all together to share and discuss strategies and concerns. Additionally, bring in education specialists to inform, guide, and appraise current practice.

GOAL 2 Increase family and community engagement

Families and the community are key partners in education. Over the last few years, Covid has significantly impacted school events for families and the community to engage in school events and activities.

With the removal of restrictions, we are optimistic that through new and renewed opportunities parental Involvement will greatly increase.
